

Quick & Easy Tutorial 2

Painted Harvest



SUPPLIES:

- So Saffron card stock 21cm x 14.8cm scored and folded at 10.5cm
- Soft Suede card stock 13.8cm x 9.5cm
- Very Vanilla card stock 13.3cm x 9cm plus 2cm x 6cm
- Ink – So Saffron; Crushed Curry; Crumb Cake and Soft Suede
- Linen Thread
- Liquid Glue (Tombow), Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals
- Tools – Leaf Punch; Paper Snips; Trimmer; Paper Piercing Tool; Stampin' Scrub; Stampin' Mist

Note: Painted Harvest and the Leaf Punch will be available 1st September 2017

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using Tombow adhere the Soft Suede card stock to the front of the folded card base
2. Place the Very Vanilla card on a Stampin' Pierce Mat and stamp the background flower in So Saffron, then the top flower in Crushed Curry. Take the larger of the two centre stamps and stamp in Crumb Cake, then the smaller centre stamp in Soft Suede. I stamped the images 3 times.
3. Take the dots stamp and stamp randomly in Crumb Cake – make sure you have an odd number of stamped images
4. Wrap the Linen Thread around the card 2 to 3 times and tie a knot. Take some more Linen Thread and wrap around your hand several times leaving the ends loose, then use the ends to wrap around the centre of the loops forming a 'messy' bow. Adhere to card front with Glue Dots
5. Place Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the card front and adhere on top of the Soft Suede
6. Stamp your sentiment in Soft Suede and trim giving one end a slant. Adhere to front of card with Stampin' Dimensionals

INSERT & ENVELOPE:

- Cut insert 13.5cm x 9.5cm from extra Very Vanilla card stock and use a Stampin' Up! Envelope
- Stamp in the same fashion as above in the bottom right of insert and bottom front left of Envelope.
