

Halloween Tutorial

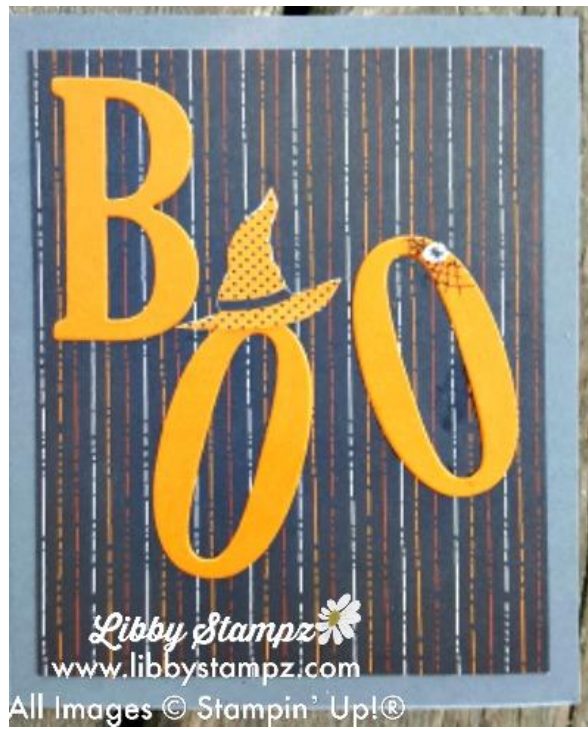


SUPPLIES:

- Basic Gray card stock 21cm x 14.8cm scored and folded at 10.5cm or 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored and folded at 4 ½"
- Basic Black card stock 14.3cm x 10cm or 5 ¼" x 4"
- Designer Series Paper (2 of – 1 for Layer 2 on card front and 1 for inside of card) 13.8cm x 9.5cm or 5" x 3 ¾"
- Pumpkin Pie card stock (moon) 7cm x 7cm or 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"; Letters 6.5cm x 10cm or 2 ½" x 4"
- Ink –Crushed Curry and Basic Black plus Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker
- Linen Thread
- Liquid Glue (Tombow), Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals
- Tools – Cat Punch; ; Paper Snips; Trimmer; Paper Piercing Tool; Stampin' Scrub; Stampin' Mist

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using Tombow adhere the Basic Black card stock and Designer Series Paper together
2. Punch cat from the DSP, pumpkins die cut with Patterned Pumpkins Framelits
3. Die cut witches hat and fussy cut.
4. Die cut the moon from Pumpkin Pie and sponge for shadows with Crushed Curry.
5. Die cut the jack-o-lanterns from the Spooky Night Designer Series Paper and cut with the Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits.
6. The moon is attached to the DSP with Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. A strand of Linen Thread was wrapped around 3 times and taped on the back. A double bow attached with a Glue Dot finishes this.
8. The pumpkins are liquid glued and the two in front attached with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. The cat is also attached with Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. This panel is adhered to the Basic Gray card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. On the inside I liquid glued letters cut from Pumpkin Pie card stock with the Large Letters Framelits to a panel of the Spooky Night DSP.
12. A witch's hat from the DSP sits atop the middle O, and a tiny spider, also from the DSP crawls on the last O.
13. Using Basic Black Stampin' Write marker to draw in a little spider web.



INSERT & ENVELOPE:

- Adhere DSP to inside of card
- The envelope front has a couple of die cut pumpkins from the DSP, and the flap has more of the striped DSP.
