

Quick & Easy Tutorial 6

Easy Gift Card Holder using Merry Café



SUPPLIES:

- Merry Café stamp set
- Coffee Café stamp set
- Coffee Cup Framelit Dies
- Carols of Christmas (holly stamp)
- Be Merry D.S.P.
- Merry little Christmas D.S.P.
- Ink – Old Olive; Cherry Cobbler
- Old Olive Mini Chevron Ribbon
- Early Espresso card stock 10.5cm x 28cm
- Score at 14cm and 23cm
- Whisper White 1 piece each 10cm x 13.3cm; 6.8cm x 4cm and 5cm x 3.8cm
- Cut 1 piece of D.S.P. from Be Merry for the cup at 5.7cm x 7.6cm
- Cut 1 piece of D.S.P. from Merry Little Christmas for card front and inside 1 each of 10cm x 8.2cm and 10cm x 4.5cm
- Liquid Glue (Tombow) and Stampin' Dimensionals
- Tools –Big Shot, Big Shot Magnetic Platform, Paper Snips; Trimmer; Paper Piercing Tool; Stampin' Scrub; Stampin' Mist

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Burnish score lines very well with Bone Folder
2. Adhere ribbon to top 1/3 of D.S.P. for card front, tie in a knot on the right and adhere D.S.P. to card front
3. Adhere 10cm x 4.5cm piece of D.S.P. to inside right of card
4. Run a bead of Liquid Glue along the top and bottom of inside left front and close to form a pocket



5. Stamp sentiment from Coffee Café to the far right of Whisper White in Old Olive
6. Stamp holly from Carols of Christmas to the top right and bottom left of sentiment. Use Cherry Cobbler and Old Olive Stampin' Write Markers
7. Adhere to inside of card
8. Stamp coffee sleeve in Old Olive on Whisper White 6.8cm x 4cm. Use the words from Merry Café – 'Happy New Year' in Cherry Cobbler; 'Christmas' in Old Olive and 'Merry' in Cherry Cobbler. Die cut using the Coffee Cups Framelit dies
9. Stamp on Whisper White 5m x 3.8cm in Cherry Cobbler, the lid for the coffee cup from Merry Café and die cut with the Coffee Cup Framelit Dies
10. Use the D.S.P. from Be Merry to die cut a coffee cup using the Coffee Cup Framelit Dies
11. Use Liquid Glue to put all the pieces of the coffee cup together then add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the coffee cup and adhere to the front of your Gift Card
