Tea Room Suite Note Card Box

Measurements – Metric:

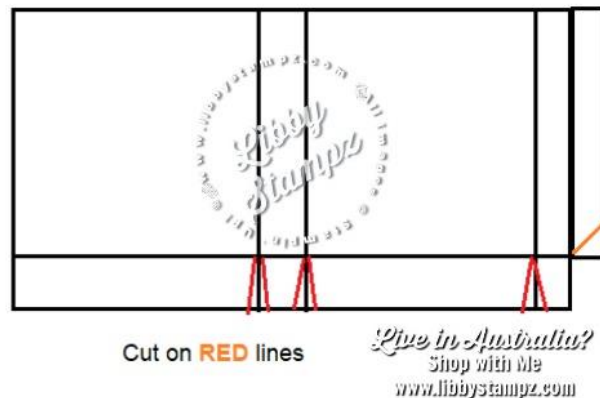
- Use A4 full sheet of card
- Cut with long side across the top of the trimmer to 7.6 cm; 18.1 cm and you are left with 2.5 cm which will be used for the belly band
- Cut the 8.75 cm piece so it is 23.75 cm; long (8.75 cm x 23.75 cm)
- Score at 9.4 cm; 10.6 cm; 21.3 cm and 22.5 cm then turn and score at 13.1 cm and 15 cm
- Cut the 9.4 cm piece to 25 cm (9.4 cm x 25 cm)
- Score at 13.1 cm and 15 cm
- Cut extra card to 9.7 cm x 9.1 cm and 9.7 cm x 6.6 cm
- Cut D.S.P. – 9.4 cm x 8.7 cm and 9.4 cm x 6.3 cm

Measurements – Imperial:

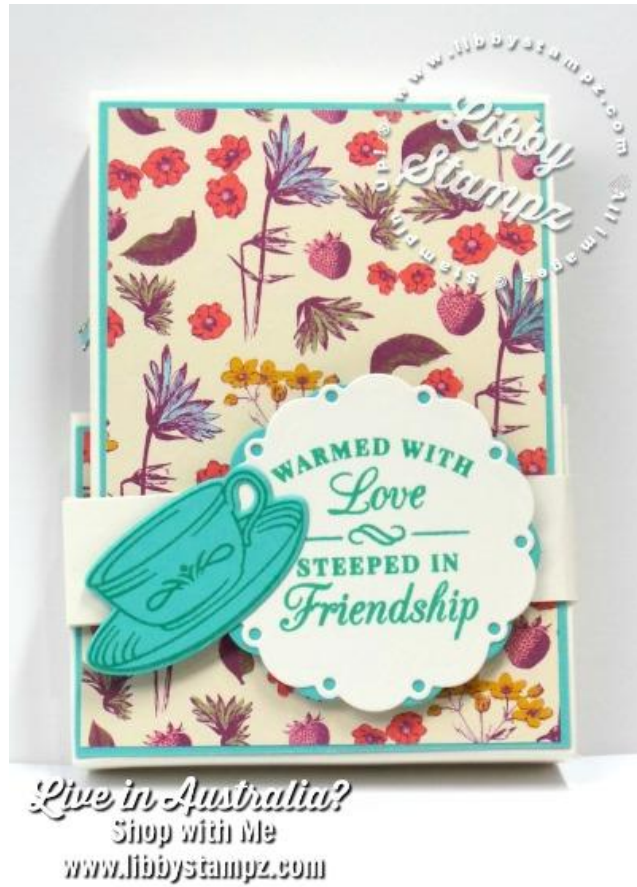
- Use 11" full sheet of card
- Cut with long side across the top of the trimmer to 3 ½"; 7 ¼" and you are left with 1" which will be used for the belly band
- Cut the 3 ½" piece so it is 9 ½": long (3 ½" x 9 ½")
- Score at 3 ¾"; 4 ½"; 8 ½" and 9" then turn and score at 5 ¼" and 6"
- Cut the 3 ¾" piece to 10" (3 ¾" x 10")
- Score at 5 ¼" and 6"
- Cut extra card to 3 7/8" x 3 5/8" and 3 7/8" x 2 5/8"
- Cut D.S.P. – 3 ¾" x 3 ½" and 3 ¾" x 2 ½"

Instructions:

- Use the measurement and scoring guide under measurements to cut and score the card
- Burnish all score lines.
- Cut the 23.75 cm or 9 ½” piece on the bottom up to the score line.
- Mitre your cuts to make it easier to put the box together. See template below.



- Use Tear & Tape on the end which is cut away. Bring the other side up, so it lines up with the fold. Press down to make the box.
- Check the closure of the box. You may want to trim a small amount off the long tab at the bottom – only do it on one of the long tabs.
- Push the flaps down to the inside of the box. Use Liquid Glue on the tabs and fasten.
- Use Liquid Glue to fasten to final long tab and use your bone folder to ensure everything is adhered well.
- Now, with the long piece which is left over. The end which is 13.1 cm or 5 ¼” fastens to the back of the box with Liquid Glue. Line up the cardstock with the bottom of the box. The bottom of the box and the card stock meet on the bottom, no overlapping
- Attach the Designer Series Paper to the card stock pieces you have left. Then attach these 2 pieces to the front of the box and the flap when it is folded to the front.
- Wrap the belly band around the box. Have the ends meet in the front of the box? Tape together with Tear & Tape Adhesive. Make folds as you put the belly band around the box and then burnish before adhering together.
- To decorate the belly band stamp in Coastal Cabana on Very Vanilla, your chosen sentiment from the Time For Tea stamp set and then die cut with one of the scallop circles from the die set in the bundle
- Stamp the teacup on Coastal Cabana card in Coastal Cabana and die cut out
- Attach the cup to the sentiment piece with Liquid Glue
- Place Stampin’ Dimensionals on the back of this piece and attach it to the Belly Band
- Slip the Belly Band over the box, keeping the flap in place.
- This box will easily fit 4 decorated Note Cards with Envelopes and a sachet of tea or coffee and would make a great gift.
