## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Floral Essence Stamp Set (149450)
- **Card Stock** – Shimmery White A4 Card Stock (121717); Rococo Rose A4 Card Stock (150888); Whisper White A4 Card Stock (106549)
- **Stamp Pads** – Rococo Rose Ink (150080); Granny Apple Green Ink (147095); Daffodil Delight Ink (14704); Versamark Pad (102283)
- **Misc.** – Floral Essence Bundle (151055); Perennial Flower Punch (149522); ½” Circle Punch (119869); Leaf Punch (144667); Rectangle Stitched Framelits Dies (148551); Blender Pens (102845); White Stampin' Emboss Powder (109132); Whisper White C6 Envelopes (106588); Embossing Buddy (103083); Heat Tool (129056); Liquid Multipurpose Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Glue Dots (103683); Bone Folder (102300)

## Measurements:

- Card Stock 1 – Rococo Rose: 8 ½” x 5 ½” or 21 cm x 14.9 cm; scraps for (2) Perennial Flower
- Card Stock 2 – Whisper White: 5 ¼” x 4” or 14.4 cm x 10 cm plus scrap for flower centre, leaves and sentiment
- Card Stock 3 – Shimmery White: 5” x 3 ¾” or 13.9 cm x 9.5 cm

## Instructions:

1. Score and fold card base at 4 ¼” or 10.5 cm
2. Adhere card 2 using Liquid Glue
3. On card 3 use Rococo Rose ink to randomly stamp the large open flower; then fill in the spaces with leaves using Granny Apple Green
4. Use a Blender Pen and the corresponding colours, to colour the leaves and partially colour the flowers, following the lines given on the stamp
5. On a scrap of Whisper White stamp, the sentiment in Rococo Rose and die cut using the Rectangle Stitched Framelits Dies
6. Place 3 Stampin’ Dimensionals on the back
7. On another scrap of Whisper White, use Granny Apple Green to stamp 3 leaves and then punch these out using the Leaf punch
8. Using Daffodil Delight stamp one flower centre and punch out with the ½” Circle punch
9. Wipe the Rococo Rose Card over with an embossing buddy and use Versamark to stamp 2 of the flowers.
10. Sprinkle with White Stampin’ Emboss Powder and heat set using your Heat Tool
11. Punch out using the Perennial Flower Punch
12. Use your Bone Folder to slightly curl the petals
13. Adhere the 2 sets of Petals and the flower centre with Liquid Glue and place a Stampin’ Dimensional on the back
14. Adhere the leaves to the under side of the flower using Glue Dots
15. Put the card front together and then adhere to the card using Liquid Glue
