

Press On Slimline Gatefold Card

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Press On Stamp Set (153392)
- **Card Stock** – Early Espresso Card Stock (121686)); Whisper White Card Stock (106549)
- **Stamp Pads** – Early Espresso Ink (147114)
- **Misc.** – In Good Taste Designer Series Paper (DSP) (152494); Early Espresso ¼" Faux Suede Trim (152472); Stitched Rectangle Dies (148551); Blender Pens (102845); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

- Card Stock 1: 8" x 10 ½" or 21 cm x 27 cm; 3 ¼" x 8 ¼" or 21 cm x 8.5 cm for the cars insert; plus, a scrap for sentiment & coffee cup
- Card Stock 2: 3 ¼" x 8 ¼" or 21 cm x 8.5 cm – trim diagonally. Plus, scrap for sentiment
- DSP: 3" x 8" or 20.5 cm x 8 cm – trim diagonally

Instructions:

- Score at 3 ½" and 7" or 9 cm and 18 cm
- Fold the scored sections in toward the centre and burnish the fold lines
- Line up a corner with the opposite end of the scored line along the cutting line of your paper trimmer (either corner is fine)
- Cut diagonally across the section between these two points to create one side of the gate fold
- Cut a parallel line on the other end panel. You will line up with the opposite corner and cut to the end of the score line on the other side of the panel.
- The cut sections should meet at the centre, giving your card a diagonal opening.

- Trim both the layered panel and DSP diagonally and adhere to the card front
- Tie a multiloop bow using the Early Espresso ¼" Faux Suede Trim and adhere to the lower left of the card front using a Glue Dot
- Stamp the coffee cup from Press On in Early Espresso and use a Blender Pen to move some of the colour onto the cup surface.
- Place Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the cup at the top and adhere to top gatefold piece.
- Stamp the sentiment in Early Espresso and die cut using the Stitched Rectangle Dies adhere to another slightly larger Stitched Rectangle Dies in Early Espresso, with Liquid Glue. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the sentiment piece and adhere to the card front where shown.
- Use Early Espresso to stamp the line of coffee cups on the card insert, then adhere to the inside of the card



- Make an envelope from the In Good Taste Designer Series Paper (DSP) cut to 10 ½" x 12" or 21 cm x 30 cm
- Score on short side at 2" and 6" or 5.2 cm and 15 cm
- Score on long side at 1 ½" and 10 ¼"
- See template for cutting and remove areas as indicated.
- Place adhesive where indicated and allow to dry before placing completed card inside
